

## INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA intended for users who consult the Website pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679

Dear user,

Please read this information carefully, prepared pursuant to art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter the Regulation, GDPR) which describes the methods of processing the personal data of users who consult the website of Gamma Chimica SpA (hereinafter Gamma Chimica). This information concerns exclusively the website of Gamma Chimica.

### Data Controller

### Types of data processed

#### Browsing data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers and terminals used by users, the URI/URL ( Uniform Resource Identifier /Locator) addresses of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numeric code indicating the status of the response data from the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's IT environment.

Browsing data does not persist for more than seven days (except in the event of the need to ascertain crimes by the judicial authorities).

#### Data communicated by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of messages to the contact addresses of Gamma Chimica, messages sent by users to institutional profiles/pages on social media, as well as the compilation and forwarding of the forms on the site, entail the acquisition of the sender's contact data, necessary to respond, as well as all personal data included in the communications.

#### Cookies and other tracking systems

No cookies are used to profile users, nor are other tracking methods employed.

### Intended for data

Your data may be shared with third parties/entities and, pursuant to art. 28 of the Regulation, appointed as external data processing responsibilities. Such parties/entities are:

- designated persons who act on the basis of specific instructions provided by the controller to process personal data and who have undertaken to maintain confidentiality or have an appropriate legal obligation of confidentiality;
- subjects delegated and/or appointed by the owner to carry out activities strictly related to the pursuit of the purposes indicated above (including technical maintenance interventions on the systems), duly appointed as data controllers;
- persons, companies or professional firms that provide assistance and consultancy to the owner, duly appointed as data controllers;
- subjects, entities or authorities to whom the communication of your personal data is mandatory by virtue of provisions of law or orders of the competent authorities.

Gamma Chimica does not transfer to third countries; it does not have an automated decision-making process relating to natural persons and does not carry out profiling.

The data may be transferred to countries within the EU and outside the EU; such transfers may be carried out by entities and/or companies receiving the data as specified above under the heading “ data recipients” .

### RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

Interested parties have the right to obtain from Gamma Chimica, access to their personal data and the correction or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the processing that concerns them or to oppose the processing (articles 15 and following of the Regulation). Interested parties who believe that the processing of personal data relating to them carried out through this site occurs in violation of the provisions of the Regulation have the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor, as provided for by art. 77 of the Regulation itself at the address ( <https://www.garanteprivacy.it/web/guest/home/docweb/-/docweb-display/docweb/4535524> ).

### How to exercise your rights

Upon receipt of the request to exercise the rights, the privacy contact will contact the company DPO who will take care of satisfying the interested party's request. If it is not possible for the interested party to send this request via email, it can be sent by ordinary mail via registered mail to the company's registered office : Gamma Chimica SpA via Lepetit 8, 20045 Lainate (MI).

The exercise of the rights by the user is free of charge pursuant to art. 12 GDPR. However, in the case of manifestly unfounded or excessive requests, also due to their repetitiveness, the owner may charge the user a reasonable fee, in light of the administrative costs incurred to manage his request, or deny the satisfaction of his request.
